

Showcasing the Value of Psychiatric Pharmacists

High quality research that supports the integration of psychiatric pharmacists into mental health care teams is critical for the advancement of the profession. With the support of AAPP, the Foundation is funding a \$250,000 research grant intended to generate a high-quality, large sample size (n) data set that evaluates the impact of integrating psychiatric pharmacists into team-based mental health care in studies with multiple research sites and investigators. The funding of additional outcomes research grants is a priority of both AAPP and the Foundation in the near future.



Growing Psychiatric Pharmacy Trainees

With the ongoing mental health, substance use, and suicide crises, the Foundation's work in attracting and growing future psychiatric pharmacists is more important than ever. Through its annual grant program, student pharmacists have the opportunity to evaluate a career in psychiatric pharmacy by attending the AAPP Annual Meeting. This experience allows dozens of students to develop professional networks and acquire knowledge through programming and mentoring opportunities.

Expanding Psychiatric Pharmacy Practice

Advancing the reach and practice of psychiatric pharmacy to improve mental health care is a focus for AAPP Foundation. Through its new practice expansion grant program, the Foundation will be able to fund two, high-quality improvement projects that support the integration of psychiatric pharmacists into mental health care teams. These grants are intended to support quality improvement where the financial return on investment is insufficient to progress without additional funding. Proposals that increase utilization of psychiatric pharmacists in a primary care setting or a certified community behavioral health clinic (CCBHC) will be prioritized in year 1 of this grant program.
